



In the Democratic Republic of the Congo, WHO and partners rapidly and effectively coordinate the response to Ebola

On 6 June 2017 multidisciplinary teams in the Democratic Republic of the Congo are faced with numerous challenges as they respond to an outbreak of Ebola virus disease in the remote, forested regions in the northern part of the country - impassable roads, limited telecommunications coverage, lack of infrastructure and of basic services. In the grounds of a former convent, WHO and other partner agencies led by the Ministry of Health have secured and set up a base to coordinate their work and end the outbreak as quickly and as safely as possible.
